Between

THE UNITED NATIONS EDUCATIONAL, SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATION OFFICE IN JAKARTA (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "UNESCO JAKARTA")

and

CONSELHO DE IMPRENSA DE TIMOR-LESTE (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS TLPC) UNIVERSIDADE NACIONAL TIMOR LOROSA'E (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS UNTL) UNIVERSIDADE ORIENTAL TIMOR LOROSA'E (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS UNITAL)

THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE PROJECT "STRENGTHENING MEDIA SELF-REGULATORY MECHANISMS IN TIMOR-LESTE"

Whereas, UNESCO Jakarta, TLPC, UNTL, and UNITAL (hereinafter referred to collectively as "the Parties") recognize the importance of a free, independent and pluralistic media in Timor-Leste,

Whereas, the Parties are mindful of the objectives of the project "Strengthening Media Self-Regulatory Mechanisms in Timor-Leste",

The Parties have agreed to the following cooperation between the four institutions:

- i. Building the capacity of journalism students in practical journalistic skills.
- ii. Building the capacity of journalism students in the understanding of professionalism, journalistic code of ethics as well as self-regulation of the media.

The implementation of the above cooperation shall be concluded in another arrangement by the Parties.

This present Letter of Intent will enter into force on the date of the signature and will remain valid until 30 June 2020. It may be renewed or terminated after evaluation and mutual agreement by the Parties.
